

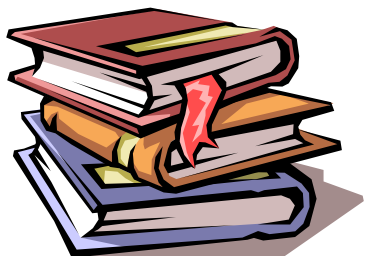
Background
